### How to get to us

You would like to gain international work experience and start your career in the German healthcare sector? Then apply to SLG St. Paulus GmbH and become part of our team. To do so, please send us a short cover letter, your CV, all educational and work references translated into German and notarized, as well as a language proficiency certificate (German level C1).

We will then review your documents and if you have convinced us, we will invite you to an online interview.

In addition to this application process, you can already inform yourself independently about the legal requirements you need to start working in Germany.

After you have been accepted by us, we will be happy to support you in the further recognition process, for example with the search for an apartment, a language course or even with setting up a bank account. We also offer a special familiarization program for employees from abroad, including assistance from a mentor during the first few months or support from our practical supervisors.

Until your qualifications are recognized, you will be employed as a nursing assistant. To work as a nursing specialist (m/f/d), you need to have your professional qualifications officially recognized. You can already apply for recognition of your foreign qualifications and training in the field of professional healthcare from abroad. We have compiled a list of the most important links for you.

Please keep in mind that each recognition process is treated on an individual basis.

### General conditions

Once you have submitted an application for recognition of your professional qualifications and obtained all the required documents and an employment contract, it is possible for you to apply for a visa. Applicants from non-EU countries must have a visa with a residence permit. Applicants from EU countries do not need this.

In order to obtain a residence permit, your vocational training must be recognized. You can still apply for a visa even if a deficit has been identified that shows significant differences between your vocational training and the equivalent German training. This deficit can then be compensated during your employment with us.

### Organizational procedure

1. Initiate recognition procedure
  - a. In case of a deficit notification, check the compensation possibilities
2. Signed employment contract
3. Visa application
4. Entry into Germany
5. Arrangement of an appointment with the immigration office (within 14 days after entry)
